Statement of Faith and Moral Principles of the Wesley-  
an Covenant Association

#### Section 4. Statement on Biblical Authority.

Given the current challenges directed to the unique  
place of the Bible in the church, we affirm that the  
core of the Christian faith is revealed in Scripture as  
“the faith that was once for all entrusted to the  
saints” (Jude 3; NRSV). We look to the Bible therefore  
as our authority and trustworthy guide, which “is use-  
ful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for  
training in righteousness” (2 Timothy 3:16; NRSV).  
Illuminated by tradition, reason, and experience, the  
revelation of Scripture is the church’s primary and fi-  
nal authority on all matters of faith and practice.

#### Section 5. Statement of Faith

A. Doctrinal Standards. We affirm classical Wesleyan  
doctrine and the historic faith, which the church has  
used to define the parameters of Christian teaching.  
Doctrine, properly understood, unifies the church  
and gives direction to its life. All congregational,  
clergy, and lay members of the WCA affirm the fol-  
lowing Doctrinal Standards:

1. The Nicene Creed (AD 381)
2. The Articles of Religion of the Methodist  
Church (AD 1808)
3. The Confession of Faith of the Evangelical  
United Brethren Church (AD 1963)
4. The Standard Sermons of John Wesley
5. The Explanatory Notes Upon the New  
Testament by John Wesley (1755)
6. General Rules of The Methodist Ch (1868)
