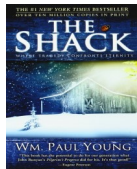

Their performance of this song maybe got you to thinking about the words in the song title. What does “Easter” and “Hallelujah” really mean?

Of course, we all think we know about “Easter”, but you might be surprised to know it is not biblical. Easter is not a term used at all in the Bible. The word Easter originates from the ancient term Eostre, which is a reference to the season of Spring.

“Hallelujah” is an equally familiar term to all of us, but do you know what it means when you say or sing it? The term is mentioned 24 times in the Bible, most often in the book of Psalms. Hallelujah means - Praise Ye The LORD!
