Sunday Morning Devotional

Oh man, if I only had a grip on this little bit of wisdom for the better part of my life! Countless are the times when I have flown off the handle, refusing to listen, determined to make my point. So often I have gotten angry. That anger has all too frequently had roots in my pride. "Don't they know who I am?" At every single incidence of my angry expressions of, *opinion*, there has been an unforeseen consequence, it has always reared up and bitten me back. Worse, in every one of those times, I have been made the fool. Fortunately, I am slowly learning to keep my heart and my ears open and to ask God before I speak, "Is this a good thing I am thinking and about to say?"

A mentor once told me that before we say anything, we should ask ourselves three questions. Is it kind? Is it true? And is it necessary? If we all followed that process, the world would be a much quieter and without a doubt, a more peaceful place. We all have two ears and one mouth, so we should listen twice as much as we speak.

As Christ forgave you and me and loves us all - we must remember to keep these truths in mind and ever in front of our inclination to speak in haste or in anger. How marvelous a thing that the Son of God bore all our sins, endured unimaginable torture and hung on a cross out of love. How deep and eternal is that love, which should govern our every action, precede our every word. We all need to learn that we don't need to be right, to be right in the sight of the God—His GRACE is sufficient. Try this prayer:

"Lord TODAY I will live out in my actions the two greatest commandments, to love You with all my heart, my soul and my mind and to love my neighbor, as myself. I will listen carefully and speak even more carefully. I will not allow my pride to govern my thoughts or what comes out of my mouth. I will seek Your face and live in GRACE. Amen"
